ODIHR observes that Kyrgyzstan has not reported on hate crimes separately from cases of hate speech.

Official Data

Figures include extremist crimes and crimes of incitement to hatred. A further 37 cases of “organized actions aimed at the incitement to national, racial, religious and inter-regional hatred” were also reported.
