ODIHR observes that Kyrgyzstan has not reported data and information on hate crimes to ODIHR since 2013. In the absence of an official submission and statistics, ODIHR is not able to provide further observations on hate crime data collection in Kyrgyzstan. In addition, ODIHR observes that Kyrgyzstan would benefit from raising awareness among and building the capacity of criminal justice officials to address hate crimes.

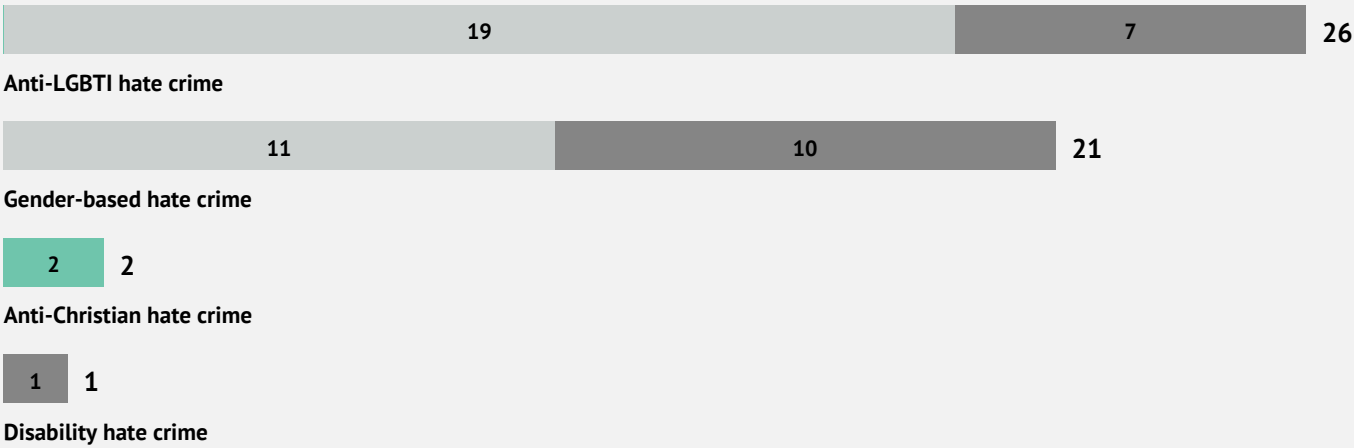

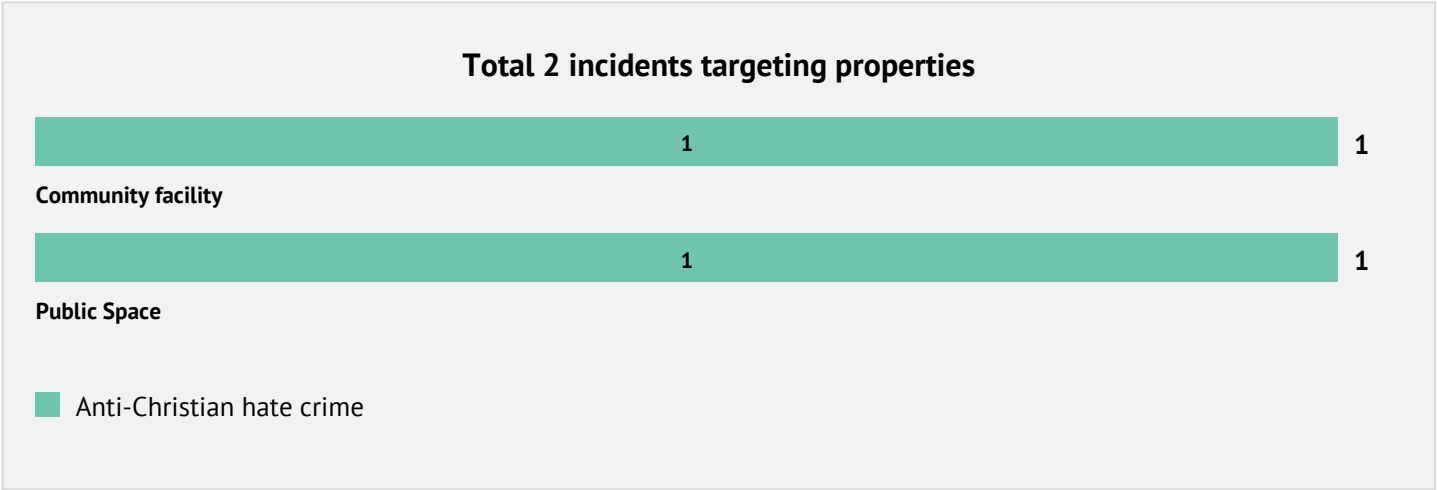

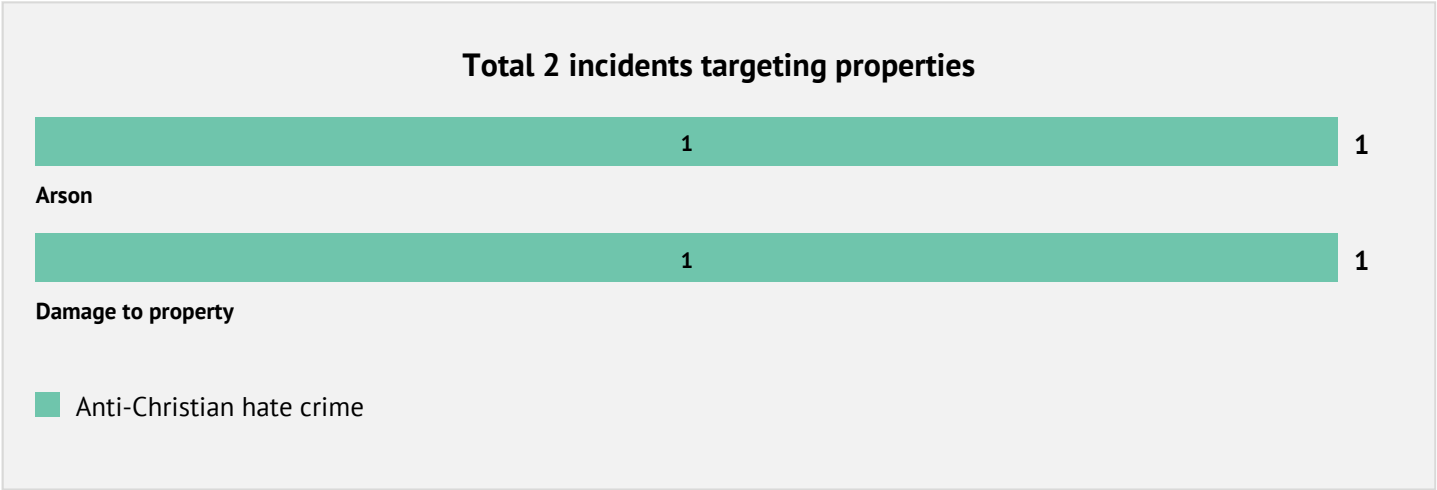
