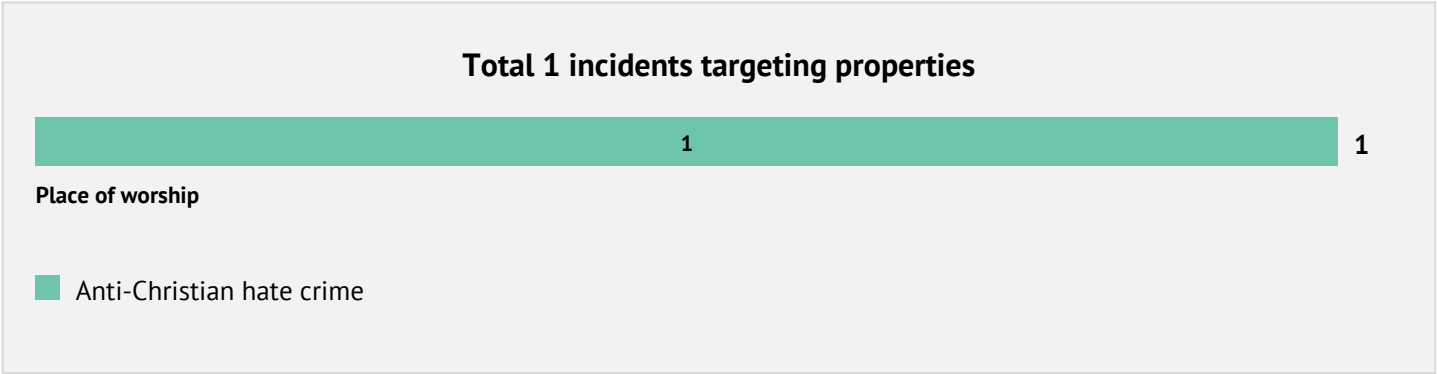

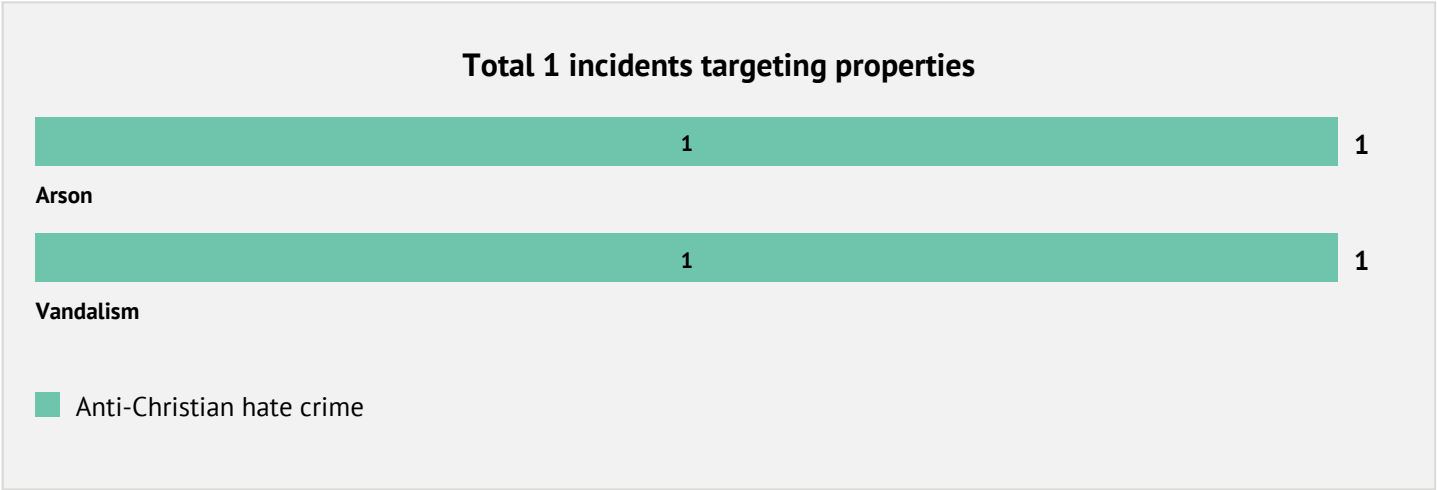
Threats/Harassment Attacks against property
