ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR recognizes Liechtenstein's efforts in reporting on hate crime to ODIHR as well as the increase in the number of hate crimes recorded by police. However, based on the available information, it observes that the law enforcement agencies of Liechtenstein have not recorded the bias motivations of hate crimes. In addition, ODIHR observes that Liechtenstein would benefit from raising the awareness and building the capacity of criminal justice officials about hate crimes.

Official Data

The numbers reported here refer to the crime of discrimination, which may include some cases that are within the OSCE's definition of hate crime.
