ODIHR's Key Observation

ODIHR recognizes Liechtenstein's efforts to report hate crime to ODIHR. However, based on the available information, it observes that Liechtenstein's law enforcement agencies do not record the bias motivations of hate crimes. In addition, ODIHR observes that Liechtenstein would benefit from raising awareness among and building the capacity of criminal justice officials to address hate crime.

Official Data

The numbers reported here refer to the crime of discrimination according to Section 283 of the Criminal Code of Liechtenstein. The numbers may therefore include cases that fall outside of the OSCE's definition of hate crime.
